Tax refunds ready

On October 17, the Oregon State Department of Revenue will be dropping more than one-half million checks amounting to \$75 million in the mail. These are the second checks this year going to homeowners and renters to help them pay their property taxes.

The 1977 legislature changed the property tax refund program to provide for refund checks to be mailed in October instead of next spring. The thinking behind the change is that persons may be able to better use their Property Tax Refund to help pay their property taxes.
