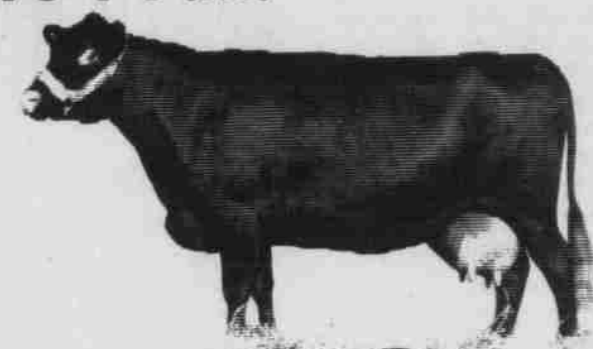

### PUBLIC NOTICE

The Ione Planning Commission and City Council will hold a public hearing to obtain comments on the Ione Draft Comprehensive Plan on Monday, January 16, 1977, at 7:30 p.m. at the Ione City Hall. Copies of the Draft Comprehensive Plan were mailed to all residents of Ione on Friday, January 6, 1978.

The Ione Draft Technical Report will be available for review beginning in January, 1978, at the Ione City Hall, the Morrow County Planning Department in Heppner, the East Central Oregon Association of Counties office in Pendleton, and the Department of Land Conservation and Development office in Salem. Material will be added to the technical report as developed through May, 1978. The draft plan objectives will be revised, after review and comment, to be adopted as city policy.

Land presently in agricultural use has been included within the proposed urban growth boundary. After adoption of the plan and growth boundary any land within the boundary may continue to be farmed until the landowner decides to convert the land to urban uses. Such conversion is subject to city, county, and state policies and regulations.
