Notice is given hereby that an application has been filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Allen Hughes for approval of a change in point of diversion from Little Butter Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 2707, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of W.A. Wilcox, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.41 cubic foot per second from Little Butter Creek for irrigation of a certain 13.8 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, 3.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and 3.5 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 12, T 2 S, R 28 E, WM, with a date of priority of 1898.

Woodward, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.32 cubic foot per second from Little Butter Creek for irrigation of a certain 3.5 acres in NE 1/4 SW 1/4 and 7.0 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 12; and 9.5 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 13, T 2 S, R 28 E, WM, with a date of priority of 1872.

BEFORE THE COUNTY COURT FOR MORROW COUNTY ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF INCREASING CERTAIN FEES FOR SOLID WASTE FRANCHISE

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Ordinance enacted by and for Morrow County requires the County Court to establish, increase, or decrease fees for franchise service; and

WHEREAS, a fee increase for the first can and each additional can was requested by the franchisees to the Solid Waste Management Board; and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Board ascertained that miles traveled in outlying areas other than incorporated areas together with increased operating costs was not economical under the current monthly fees charged for one can, or two or more cans for disposal; and

WHEREAS, after proper publications, and there being no remonstrances timely filed, the Solid Waste Management Board recommended to the County Court that an additional \$0.50 per month per can increase for the first can and \$0.50 per month per can additional can be allowed.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that \$0.50 increase be allowed and the revised rate for one additional can, the rate shall be \$2.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the \$0.50 increase shall apply only to the areas outside the incorporated city limits of Morrow County. This Order shall be effective March 1, 1978.
