The Oregon Veterans Civic Council, an organization formed by federal, state, and local veteran service agencies, is planning a Veterans' Counseling and Information Center to be held at the Pendleton National Guard Armory May 17 and 18.

The center will provide information and direct assistance to veterans, wives, widows, dependents, and also employers in Morrow and Umatilla counties. It is estimated more than 8,000 veterans live in this area, and many of them are not aware of their veterans' benefits.
