## Pebble Springs nuke plant hearing date scheduled

A hearing on whether the proposed Pebble Springs Nuclear Plant will be able to meet environmental standards is scheduled for June 36 in Portland.

Portland General Electric hopes to construct the \$2.5 billion plant on a site near Arlington.

The hearing is expected to continue through August, according to Oregon Department of Energy officials. In addition to environmental questions, the hearing will focus on PGE's financial and operational abilities to build and run the nuclear plant.

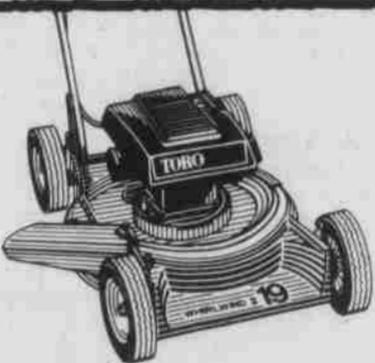
