## Hunter safety program set for Sept 11-14

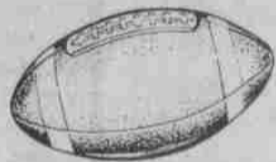
A hunter education course will be held Sept. 11-14, under the sponsorship of the Morrow County Search and Rescue Posse.
