

## Storm causes power outages here

A Columbia Basin Electric Cooperative spokesman announced that power was disrupted over a wide area in southern Morrow County Monday evening as a result of high winds and snow.

Approximately 30 consumers were without power for four hours in the Gurdane-Vinson area east of Heppner

after electrical power lines were blown together, short-circuiting the distribution system. Service was restored by 8 p.m. to that segment of the cooperative's service area.

A second series of outages occurred at 8:20 p.m. Monday in the Hardman-Parker Mill

area south of Heppner when trees broken off by high winds fell across power lines. Approximately 25 consumers

were affected by this outage. Power was restored to all consumers by 8:30 a.m. Tuesday morning.

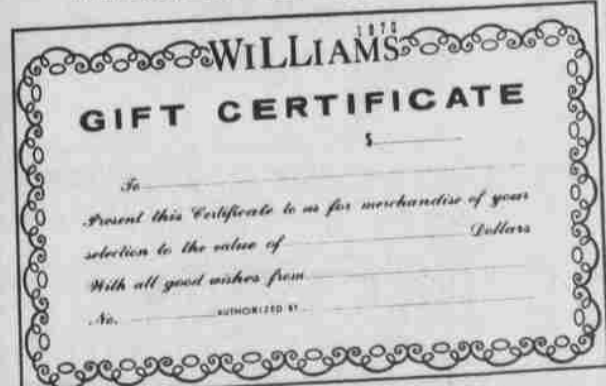
