North First Street, Hermiston, Oregon, 97838, announces that it is making an application for a loan from the Rural Electrification Administration which will provide for the construction of 6 miles of 115,000 volt transmission line.

The 115,000 volt facility will consist of approximately 6 miles of single pole transmission line running on a twenty foot wide right-of-way from the Southeast Corner of Section 11, Township 3 North, Range 25 EWM; thence 1 mile North along Homestead Road thence 3 miles East along Homestead Road to the Southeast Corner of Section 5, Township 3 North, Range 27 EWM; thence 1 mile East to Ordinance Substation located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 33, Township 4 North, Range 27 EWM; Morrow County, Oregon.

This line will make it possible for the Cooperative to provide greater reliability of service for customers served from Bonneville Power Administration Boardman's and McNary's points of delivery.

If there are any comments on the environmental aspects of the proposed construction, they should be submitted in writing to the Cooperative within 30 days of the publication of this notice. Route maps of the proposed line may be seen at the office of the Cooperative.

SEALED BIDS will be received by the Heppner District Ranger or his representative, P.O. Box 7, Heppner, Oregon 97836, up to and not later than 10:00 a.m., local time at place of bid opening December 14, 1978 for an estimated 319 acres of designed post and pole material. The minimum acceptable bid per acre is \$2.50. Additional deposit required for road maintenance (surface rock replacement) on National Forest roads over the appraised route is \$0.64 per acre. Bid rates and required deposits will be applied to all units as provided by the payment provisions of the contract. All included timber, except that not meeting Utilization Standards, is subject to Timber Export and Substitution Restrictions. Bidders are advised that violations of the Timber Export and Substitution Restrictions constitute breach of contract and may result in contract cancellation, refusal to award other timber sales to violator, and/or debarment or suspension from bidding on future timber sales. The required bid guarantee is \$200.00. Applicable Purchaser road credits are none. The right to reject any and all bids is reserved.
