SCHOOL DISTRICT MEETING

The Board of Directors of the Morrow County School District will hold its regular meeting at 7:30 p.m., Monday, Jan. 15 in the Ione High School Library.

Among items to be discussed will be the district's transportation policy.

The board will hear a report

on proposed changes in state standards and will also consider a number of personnel items, including procedures for the selection of administrators for new schools to open next year, and the renewal of contracts for two of the district's administrators.

(1) Refunds: The full amount of deposit for documents will be refunded to actual bidders upon return of the documents,

unmutilated and without marks or annotations at or before the time set for opening bids. Other deposits will be refunded with deductions for the actual cost of reproduction of the documents under the same conditions. Bidders not bidding after making deposit and not returning documents before addenda time, will forfeit half of their deposit.

The bidder is required to furnish (10 per cent) ten per cent of the Base Bid in the form of a certified check, a bank cashier's check, or a Bid Bond, representing a guarantee that he shall execute all items as outlined in the documents, specifications and plans.

D. Right to Reject Bids:
(1) The right is reserved to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities.
(2) No bidders may withdraw his bid after the time set for the opening thereof, unless the award of the contract is delayed for a period exceeding thirty (30) days.

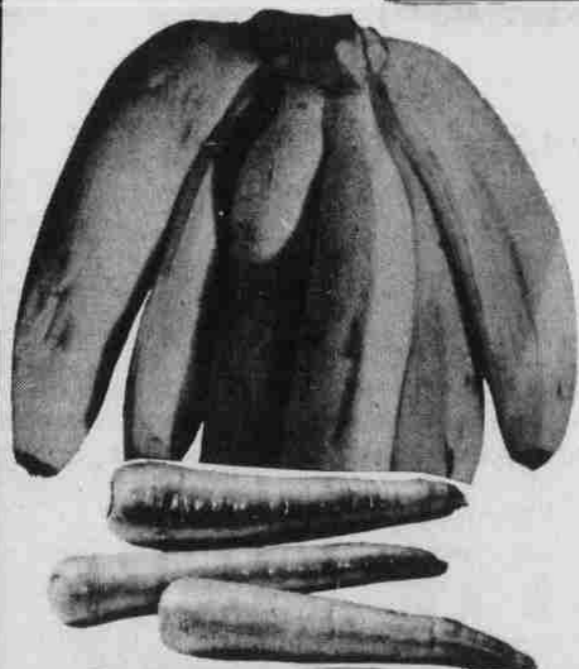

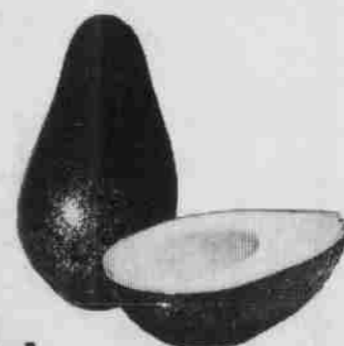
