This year the champion in each class will have their own pen to roam around in.

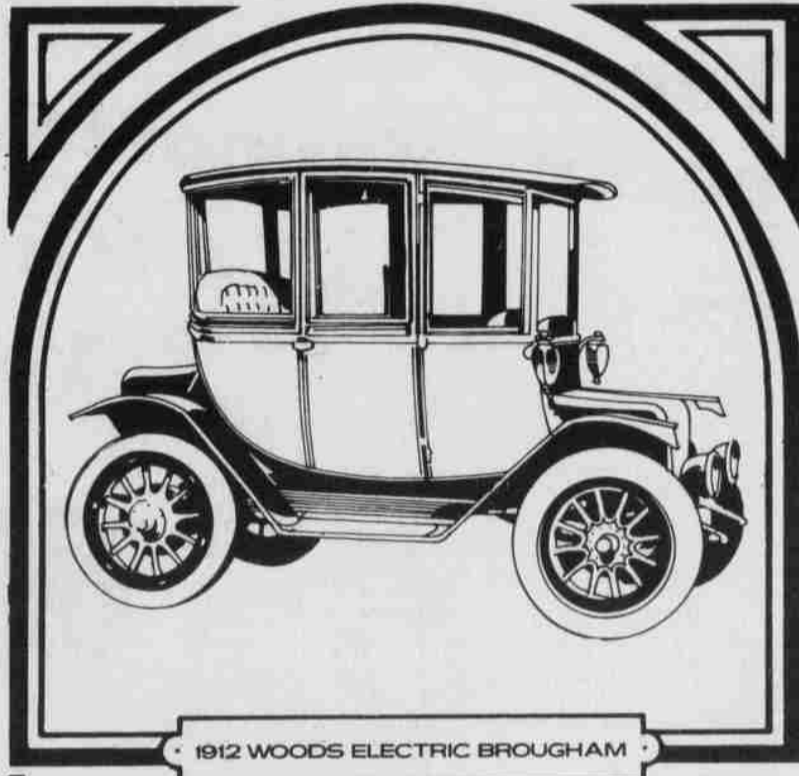
With this new addition, 4-H leaders hope to give more recognition to those animals that are the tops in their class. They will be located together so you will know where to find all of the champions.
