### Blue Mountain board meets at Ione High

The Blue Mountain Community College board of education was to meet at the Ione High School Wednesday. Items on the agenda were to include providing the hand-

capped access to the college's business department in Pendleton. The department is up a short flight of stairs in Morrow Hall. The fact that the staircase curves and that

support pillars are at the base of the stairs compounds problems of access for students in wheelchairs or on crutches. Determination of the procedure for selection of an

architect to help the college plan remodeling projects for space use and handicapped access also were considered. In other business, the board was to:

—Consider adding charged savings and loan associations to depositories for college funds surplus to immediate needs.

—Discuss improvements toampus access road and sidewalk along Garden Avenue.

—Employ an energy consultant-engineer who will help the college develop an application for energy conservation funds. The college is currently looking at such energy conserving projects as using solar energy to heat the McCrae Activity Center including the college pool.

—Review the current status of the reciprocity agreement with Walla Walla Community College.

—Meet in executive session to consider selection of a professional labor consultant.

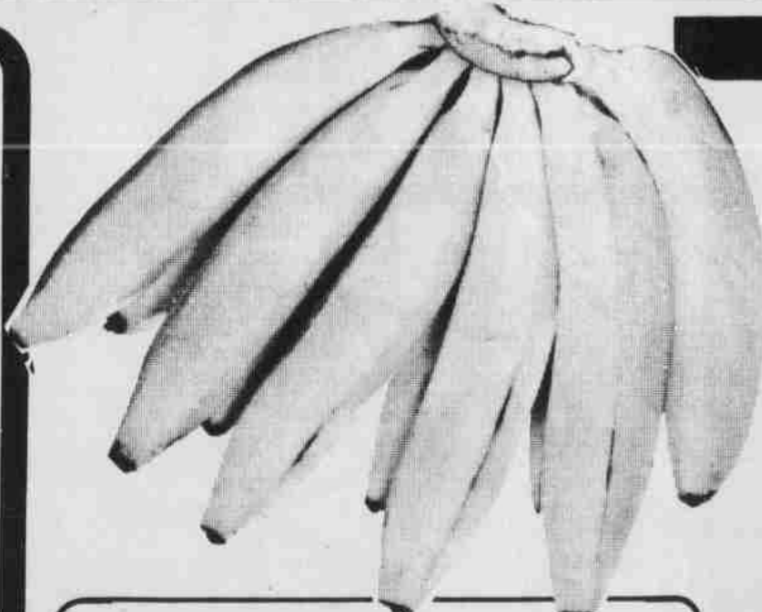

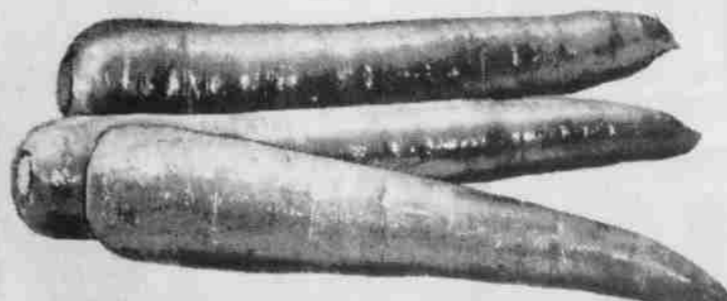
