The Water Resources Director of Oregon has received and filed an application by John B. Correa for approval, without loss of priority, of an additional point of diversion under a certain water right.

The authorized point of diversion is located 5 degrees 15' E, 3220 ft from the NW 1/4 Corner of Sec 23, being within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Sec 23, T 1N, R 27E, W 1M.

The applicant proposes to establish an additional point of diversion at a point located 2790 ft N & 500 ft W from the SE Corner of Sec 15, being within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec 15, T 1N, R 27E, W 1M.

Pursuant to ORS 540.500 (2), a hearing is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, January 9, 1980, at the Morrow County Courthouse, Heppner, Oregon.
