Jobless rate rises to 7.3% in January

Morrow County unemployment rate increased to 7.3 percent in January with 280 fewer people working than the month before.

Kinzua's shut down of the plywood plant in Heppner was the largest factor as that affected 170 workers.

Roland Stewart, of the unemployment office in Pendleton, said construction in the county was off some and work at the coal-fired plant near Boardman has reached its peak and is cutting back down in employment.

Total employment in the county was 6,450 with 470 unemployed.

The unemployment rate in the state of Oregon increased from 7.6 in December to 8.2 in January.

Oregon Congressman Al Ullman has announced the members of his staff will be in Heppner March 14 to meet individually with residents of the area.

"These meetings are scheduled on a regular basis to provide the opportunity for individuals to express their views or explain details of problems they may have with the federal government," Ullman said.
