

## Junior High boys split in track meet while girls place second

Heppner Jr. High lost to Riverside and Umatilla but beat Echo and Ukiah in a boys track meet last week in Heppner.

Riverside won the meet with 130 points, Umatilla had 127½, Heppner had 104½ points, Echo had 20 and Ukiah 13.

Greg Orr was first in the high jump, Eric Thompson third and Todd Miller fifth. Randy Smith was second in the 300 meter hurdles. Tom Hammon was fifth in the shot

put. Gary Riley was fifth in the 400 meter run.

Pat Struthers was third in the 1200 meter run. The 400 meter relay team of Orr, Miller, Mary Way and Archie Lucas was third. Thompson was second in the long jump and Smith fourth. Way was second in the softball throw and Hammon third. Struthers was third in the 800 meter run and Smith fourth.

In the 200 meter run, Lucas was second, Way third and Orr fifth. The relay team of

Damon Wilson, Gary Riley, Jimmy Cason and Mike Bergstrom placed third.

In the girls meet, the Heppner team placed second with 114 points to Riverside's 130. Umatilla was third with 70, Ukiah fourth with 57 and Echo fifth 39 team points.

Pam Orr was first in the 300 meter hurdles, Cathy Lindsay first in the shot put, Stephi Payne first in the 100 meter dash and the 200 meter run. The 400 meter relay team of

Orr, Payne, Wendy Powell and Lindsay was first. Lindsay was second in the high jump, Jodi Padberg second in the 1200 meter run, Payne second in the long jump, Orr second in the softball throw and Padberg second in the 800 meters.

Orr was third in the 400 meters, Lindsay fourth in the long jump, Powell fifth in the 100 meters and Janelle McElhany fifth in the 1200 meters. Heppner's relay team was fourth.

## Morrow athletes excel in track marks

Morrow County high school track athletes have had some good scores in meets this season, which is evident when looking at the season best results from all schools in district 7-A.

Heppner's Jim Parker has the best discus toss in the district with a throw of 144-3. Terry Starr of Ione is second at 136-11.

Parker also has the best shot put throw at 51-10.

Tracy Johnson of Riverside is first in the javelin at 181-7 with Dan Pettigrew, also of Riverside, fourth at 146-4 and Cardinal Starr sixth at 145-7.

Johnson is also second in the high jump at 6 feet with

Pettigrew third at 5-11½ and Les Thompson of Ione fourth at 5-10.

Dennis Stefani has the best long jump at 20-4½. Heppner's Earl Hammond is fifth at 19-2 and Gregg Rietmann of Ione seventh at 19-¼.

Jim Parker is second in the triple jump at 41-3¼ and Stefani of Ione sixth at 39-6.

In the pole vault, Trace Johnson is first at 11-6. Les Thompson second at 11-0 and Jerry Rietmann is tied with Thompson with a vault of 11-0.

Ione's 400 meter relay team has the third best time in the district at 46.2. Umatilla is first at 45.5.

In the 1500 meters, Larry Palmer has the third best time at 4:34.6 and Dan Nix is fourth at 4:37.9. Both competitors are from Heppner.

Treve Peterson is second in the 100 meters with a time of 11.5. Jeff Hams is fifth at 11.7 seconds.

Todd Sherer is fifth in the 400 meters at 54.9 seconds and third in the 800 meters at 2:07.

Robin LaRue is second in the 110 high hurdles at 16.1 seconds and Mike Conklin sixth at 17.9 seconds.

Gregg Rietmann has the fifth best time in the district in the 200 meters with his time of 24.1 seconds.

Robin LaRue is third in the 300 meter hurdles at 42.8 and Les Thompson is fifth at 44.3 seconds.

Dan Nix is fourth in the 3,000 meter run at 10:15.6 and Larry Palmer is sixth at 10:30.4.
