

What to do if Mt. St. Helens ash should fall

Although Oregon Communities largely have escaped the heavy ash fallout from Mt. St. Helens, some has fallen causing homemakers to wonder just how to handle it, report Oregon State University Extension Service home economists.

If your home is or should be in the path of ash from the mountain, Extension home economists have the following suggestions:

Vacuum and dust the house regularly and often, depending upon the amount of residue. The ash contains tiny sharp particles so you may wish to use the dusting attachment of the vacuum cleaner.

Check the machine often when using the vacuum. Bags should be emptied frequently, perhaps when a third full, as the ash is heavy in comparison to normal household soil. Check the vacuum's filter after every use.

Pay attention to how hot the motor is getting. If it feels warm to your hand, stop the machine and let it cool. Overheating usually means the bag is at capacity, the filter needs cleaning or the appliance is working too hard.

There may be times when the homemaker will want to use the vacuum in reverse, as an air blower to remove ash from cracks or crevices. Such action may be useful in a few situations, such as cleaning window sills, steps or lawn furniture.

Ash residue on windows leaves a white ring on the glass that appears like water spots. Wash windows first with a garden hose before using a solution of warm water and detergent to clean the glass. Vacuum the sills and around panes. Rinse the window and rinse again, using lots of water, before polishing with newspaper or soft cloth.

Be sure to check carefully before polishing to see if ash has been removed, to avoid scratching. Windows should not be washed in hot sunlight. Detergent in the water may

cause a film or spotting if applied to hot glass panes.

-For ashy laundry, shake or vacuum clothes before putting

in the washing machine. Wash using plenty of water. Wash small loads at a time using the amount of water and detergent recommended for a normal load.

Detergent is recommended because it removes particles

from clothing and suspends them in solution. Heavily soiled clothes may require a pre-rinse or an additional

clean rinse after washing. If the washing machine does not have a perforated tub, check the tub after each load

so that any ash deposits may be removed before the next load. Also check filters and dryer tubs frequently for dust

build-up. The behavior of the ash in laundry may be similar to that of beach sand caught in children's clothing.

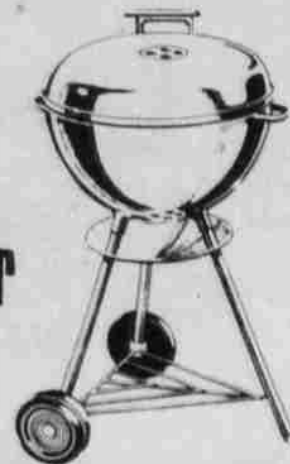

U.S. to aid fuel alcohol manufacture

The Department of Agriculture will soon begin approving grants to help finance the construction of fuel alcohol and methane plants on the nation's farms, Secretary of Agriculture Bob Bergland said.

The Department of Energy is supplying \$2.3 million which will be used to supplement loans and loan guarantees from the USDA's Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) to boost alcohol production.

Under an agreement between the Departments of Agriculture and Energy, the funds are to be used to test and demonstrate on-farm fuel production and investigate the economic feasibility of such production.

Women constitute about 16 percent of the total work force at both mines. Three shifts run everyday.

The coal seam the two mines are working on is five miles wide, 70 feet thick on the average and 80 miles long. Approximately 12 percent of all U.S. coal is in Wyoming and five percent of all U.S. coal is in Campbell County.

Amax sells the coal for \$7 a ton, said Gary Brown, assistant general manager of the Western Division of the Amax Coal Co. Amax makes a 50 cent profit on each ton. By the time the trains get to the Boardman plant, it costs PGE \$22 a ton with the difference going to the railroad companies for transportation costs.
