David, April, Christopher and Andrew Sykes spent the weekend in Portland visiting with David's sister and family. Vickie and Charlie Lewis and baby Max.

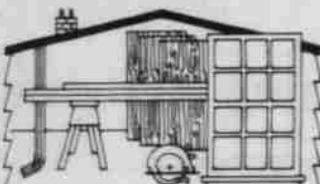

must cooperate, and that could take one year or it could take longer."

Both Chinese scientists say they plan to stay at OSU about two years, noted Trione, adding that Zhang's broad scientific training and familiarity with English will help both researchers work with scientists and farmers in Oregon and other Northwest states.

Zhang first visited the Northwest in the summer of 1979 with a Chinese delegation that discussed the TCK problem with wheat growers, scientists and others. He spoke at a recent meeting of the Oregon Wheat Commission in Portland. Yu Shan-Quin toured the wheat-producing regions of Northwest states in August and talked with wheat farmers and scientists about the TCK issue.
