Navyman returns from Pacific

Navy Chief Aviation Electronics Technician Grant S. Carter, son of Ola M. Groshens of Heppner, has returned from a deployment in the Western Pacific and Indian Ocean.

Carter is a member of Carrier Airborne Early Warning Squadron 116, based at the Miramar Naval Air Station, San Diego. While deployed, his squadron was embarked aboard the aircraft carrier USS Constellation.

During the seven-month cruise, the Constellation set a new Pacific Fleet record of 110 continuous days at sea while operating in the Indian Ocean. The embarked air wing flew more than 28,000 sorties and logged more than 10,500 arrested landings.

The ship participated in several naval exercises with units from Great Britain, Singapore, Japan, Australia and New Zealand. Port calls were made in Singapore, the Philippines and Pusan, South Korea.

The long trip home was made extra special when 350 fathers, sons and friends of the crew embarked aboard in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii, for the final leg of the homeward journey.

Carrier Airborne Early Warning Squadron 116 flies the E-2 "Hawkeye" early warning aircraft. The "Hawkeye" is outfitted with an electronically-developed radar system that is capable of long-range detection and identification of airborne targets.

Carter joined the Navy in February, 1964.

Odd Fellows, Rebekahs to hold dinner

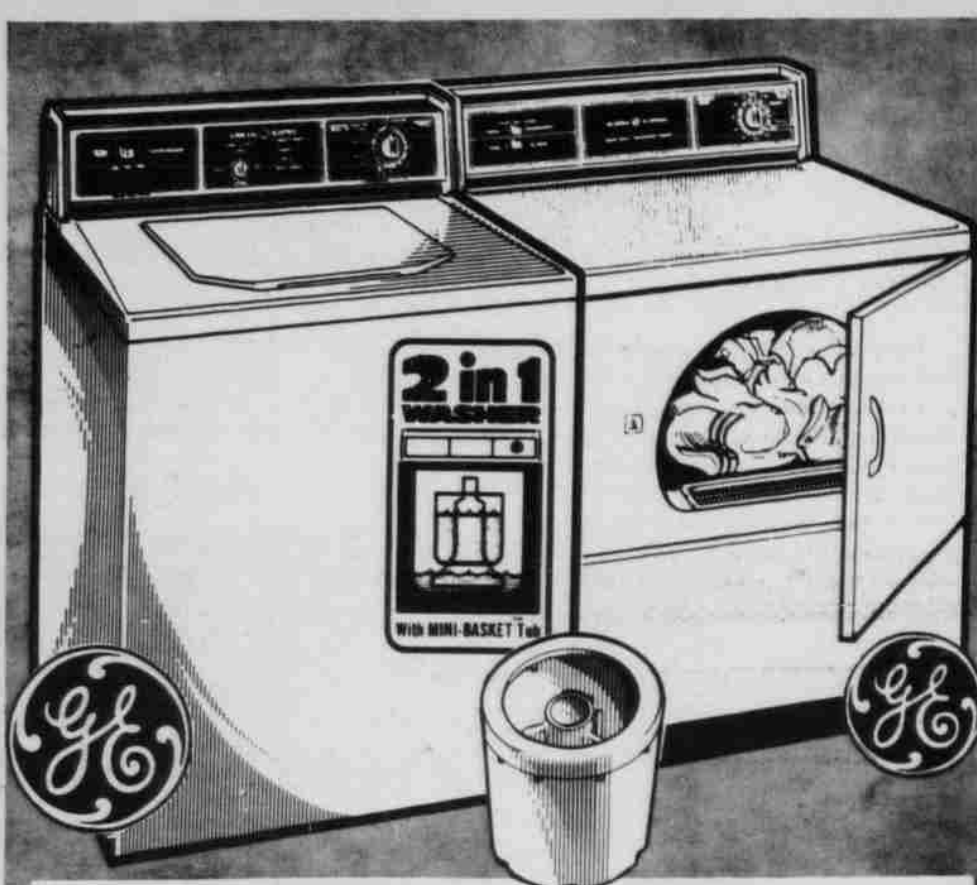
