Missionary to Kenya to speak Sunday in Heppner

The Reverend Ed Weyrick, an Assemblies of God missionary to Kenya, East Africa, will be guest speaker Sunday evening, Oct. 26, at 7 p.m. at the Christian Life Center, 197 W. Willow, Heppner. The Reverend Doug Thomas, pastor, has announced.

The Weyricks were, for the first six months of their first term of service, engaged in the study of Swahili, an Bantu language used in much of East Africa and the Congo region. They were involved in three building projects, church planting, and pastoral training on Kenya's northern frontier and Mr. Kenya-Regions.

Kenya is a relatively new mission field for the Assemblies of God; over 8,500 Kenyan believers attend 300 Assemblies of God churches and outstations in that country.

Prior to their missionary approval, the Weyricks pastored in Oregon for 12 years. Their last pastorate was at Lighthouse Assembly of God in Harbor, Oregon.

The Rev. Weyrick attended Bethany Bible College in Santa Cruz, California, and has done graduate studies at

the Assemblies of God Graduate School in Springfield, Missouri. The Weyricks have three children, Christalene, 14, Eddie, 11, and Aleta, one year.

Pastor Weyrick will be sharing the challenge of their ministry during this missions service. The public is invited to attend.

Dr. John C. Wilke, a Cincinnati, Ohio, family practitioner and president of the National Right to Life Committee, will appear in Pendleton on Friday, Oct. 24, from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. at St. Mary's Catholic Church Parish center.

Dr. Wilke and his wife, Barbara, a registered nurse, are co-authors of "Handbook on Abortion" and are currently on a national tour promoting the Right to Life viewpoint.
