

**EOHSA to meet Nov. 20**

Thursday, Nov. 20, at 7:30 p.m. in the Chaiet Restaurant, Highway 97, in Redmond, the Eastern Oregon Health Systems Agency will hold a public meeting to receive and review public comments on proposed criteria and standards for the "Appropriateness Review of End Stage Renal Disease Services and Cardiac Catheterization Services in Eastern Oregon."

Appropriateness reviews are conducted to determine how appropriately existing institutional health services are meeting the needs of the people of Eastern Oregon.

The public is urged to submit their comments in writing no later than Nov. 20.
