Solar expert to present program at Condon

A representative of Western SUN (Western Solar Utilization Network), a federal department of energy program to help foster solar power, will be at the Condon High School on Tuesday, Nov. 25, at 7:30 p.m. in the multipurpose room. The public is invited to attend the presentation.

John Steinke, who is from the Portland regional office, will present a slide show on the basic principles of solar energy and will also be available to answer questions. Special emphasis will be on tax programs for solar power and small scale residential uses of solar power.

Steinke, who has been described "a real expert in his field," is also a consultant for private construction.

Steinke will give a presentation to Condon High School students the next day on future employment in the field of solar power. He has also indicated that he will be available for individual appointments through the early afternoon on Wednesday, Nov. 26.

Sno-park permits on sale

Sno-park permits for the 1980-81 season are now on sale in Motor Vehicles Division field offices and in some winter sports stores and resort areas.

This is the third year for the sno-park permit program in Oregon. Permits are needed to park in designated and posted winter recreation areas in the state from Nov. 15 to April 30. Violators face a \$10 fine.

A daily permit sells again this year for \$1, and an annual permit for \$5.

Winter sport enthusiasts are urged to get a permit now so they will be ready when enforcement begins on Nov. 15.

Private businesses which act as agents for DMV in selling the sno-parks may charge a fee for providing the service—ten cents for a daily permit and 25 cents for annual permits—in addition to the \$1 or \$5 charged by the state. Most winter recreation resorts, as well as many sporting goods stores, sell sno-park permits.

Sno-park permit sales provide money for keeping winter recreation parking areas plowed out during the snow season. In 1979, sales of permits provided more than \$322,000 above expenses for the snow plowing program of the Highway Division.

"The Wacky Weirdos of Willoughby Castle," an animated film, will be shown, as well as a film strip about a mouse entitled "Charlie's Cheddar Cheese." Popcorn will be provided during the films.
