Deadline Friday for 'You, Your Child and Food' Extension course

The course includes three lessons mailed from the Pendleton Extension office every two weeks. There are short assignments to be completed at the end of each lesson. These will be reviewed by Mrs. Saul, and a summary

prepared. This summary will allow participants to learn from the experiences of others.

There is a \$1 fee to cover the cost of postage and necessary supplies. No grades or credit are given for the course, but each participant will receive a certificate of completion from Oregon State University.
