Ione HS track teams compete in 4-way meet

On Tuesday, April 14, the Cardinal tracksters traveled to Heppner for a 4-way meet with Heppner, Sherman, Echo and Ione.

The girls finished fourth with 21 points. Margaret Doherty was a triple winner as she placed first in the 200 meters with a time of 27.79, first in the 400 meters in 64.43, and first in the long jump with a leap of 13'11". Michelle LaRue placed fourth in the shot put with a toss of 23'5", and placed fifth in the discus with a throw of 72'2".

The boys placed second with 80 points. Howard Leavitt finished third in the high jump with a jump of 5'4", fifth in the long jump with a leap of 16'3", second in the 100 meters with time of 12.36.

Shawn LaRue placed fourth in the high jump with a jump of 5'4", and second in the 110 high hurdles with a time of 18.51. Denny Starr placed second in the javelin with a throw of 132'5", first in the discus with a toss of 117'7" and fourth in the shot put with a throw of 35'0".

Jim McCabe placed third in the javelin with a throw of 123'0", second in the 400 meters with a time of 56.55, and third in the 200 meters with a time of 25.64. Craig Hams placed second in the long jump with a leap of 18'1", fifth in the 100 meters with a time of 12.71 and fourth in the 200 in 25.66.

Brad Schmidt placed third in the long jump with a jump of 17'4", third in the 1600 meter run with a time of 5:08.6 and fourth in the 3000-meter run in 11:44.15.

Gregg Rietmann placed first in the 100 meters in 12.01, first in the 200 meters with a time of 24.56 and second in the shot put with a throw of 37'9". Treve Peterson placed third in the 400 meters in 56.89.

The Cardinals 400-relay team consisting of Leavitt, McCabe, Peterson and Rietmann finished first with a time of 48.45. The 1600 relay team consisting of Peterson, Hams, LaRue and Starr finished second with a time of 4:09.3.
