Delpha Jones retired as chairperson of the fair committee at the end of the 1980 fair after more than eight years of dedicated service. Flowers, as well as in charge of the Community Booths. Every year Delpha also worked along with Jim Wishart to organize the parade and has helped judge the floats.
