SPECIAL COWBELLES CONTEST "BUILD A BETTER BURGER CONTEST"

—OPEN TO ALL 4-H MEMBERS.

—Ground Beef for contest will be furnished by CowBelles.

—Each contestant will prepare a "burger" from start to serving. Member may bring choice of breads, toppings, seasonings, sauces, garnishes, or materials to add to the basic meat to make a creative, tasty burger. Prepare and serve on plate or tray, garnish, ready to eat.

—Contest will be judged on creativity of food combination; nutritional value of burger and foods added to meat or as garnish for product; taste ... combination of different food into or on burger to make it fast, fun, nutritious, snack or meal.

—List approximate cost per serving. Bring recipe on 5 x 8 card.

—Time limit for contest 30 minutes.

DEPT. II. LIVESTOCK

—All animals must be preregistered by August 10 at County Extension Office

—All Market Livestock must be entered on the fairgrounds by 10:00 a.m., Tuesday, August 25.

—A transportation certificate must be turned in at the time of weighing steers, to show ownership and brand. (THE BILL OF SALE ON THE BACK SIDE MUST BE COMPLETED TO SHOW TRANSFER FROM ORIGINAL OWNER.)

—All animals must appear in the show ring to be judged. All exhibitors must be able to show and handle their own animals. Animals must be gentle before bringing to the fair.

—Club members with hogs, sheep and steers not making weight are eligible to compete in showmanship or feeder classes.

—One entry per lot.

—ALL MARKET ANIMALS ARE SHOWN AS ONE BREED. CLASSES ARE DIVIDED BY WEIGHT

—All Market Steers must be polled or dehorned

—ANIMALS AND STALLS MUST BE PRESENTABLE AT ALL TIMES. Manure and waste to be piled as instructed in the general rules in the front of this book by 8:00 a.m. each morning. Premium money may be withheld if animals are unmanageable, not groomed or if stalls are dirty.

—All beef animals must be double tied: halter and neckrope or chain.

4-H HERDSMANSHIP CONTEST

—Livestock will be tied or penned in sections by club. Club signs encouraged but not required.

—Each exhibitor expected to keep his tack and stall or pen clean and presentable at all times. Dirty animals may be barred from showing. Hay and straw not to be used in bales behind animals.

—Judge will inspect stalls and pens of each club at regular intervals and keep a record to determine winners.

—ANIMALS AND STALLS MUST BE PRESENTABLE AT ALL TIMES. Manure and waste to be piled as instructed in the front of this book by 8:00 a.m. each morning. Premium money may be withheld if animals are unmanageable, not groomed or if stalls are dirty.
