were either unemployed, or working short or curtailed shifts. For the previous report (week ended Sept. 5) figures were 32,000 or 31 percent. Of the 756 sawmills in the West, 113 were closed and 271 were operating at curtailed levels. Figures for the previous report were 138 and 163. The report is for Western sawmills only. It does not include paper, plywood, particleboard or any other manufacturing operation of the Western forest products industry.

An area rich in history... that's Walla Walla. Homemakers from Morrow County have the opportunity to see some of that history, Oct. 14 on a cultural arts tour sponsored by Extension Homemakers Advisory Committee.

Plans have now been completed, and contact made, to make it an exciting and fun-filled bus trip to view a number of interesting sites. Kirkham House, a historical site, Carnegie Center, Whitman College Campus and Cultural Center, and Ft. Walla Walla are scheduled stops. Carnegie Center displays local arts and crafts, and has an interesting gift shop where local artists products are sold. Kirkham House also includes an antique shop, and an interesting little herb garden in the back yard.

Also included is a narrated bus drive thru some of the more historical parts of town, with guide Mary Kock of Walla Walla to describe the various homes and businesses. Time, too, is included for women to spend free time in the downtown area to see some of the newer or renovated businesses. Luncheon will be at the Squire Inn, where each may select the food of their choice.

Costs for the tour are \$11 for bus, \$1 donation to Kirkham House for tour, \$1.50 for Ft. Walla Walla, and your luncheon choice. Bus will leave Heppner from the city park at 7 a.m. with a stop in Lexington and Irigon to pick up passengers.

Everyone interested is welcome, both women and men. The tour is the fall annual event sponsored by the group to offer local residents the opportunity to learn more of the history of the local area. The tour includes something of interest for everyone.
