Bend corp. to staff dam quality control

Century West will write the quality control program for the \$14 million project. An on-site laboratory provided by Century West will perform testing for aggregate production.

The 150-ft. by 1,250-ft. dam is the first in the U.S. to use roller-compacted lean concrete, designed to be faster and more cost-effective than conventional methods, the news release continued.

roller-compacted concrete and reinforced concrete, among others. Century West will also monitor blasting, noise and air and water quality.

Surveying services will include construction staking, as-built surveying, surveying for quantities, and performing layout and control calculations with an on-site computer.

The dam, designed by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, is scheduled for completion next October, the release continued.

Century West Engineering Corporation of Bend has been selected by Eucon Corporation, main contractors of the Willow Creek Dam, to staff and administer quality control programs and surveying for the dam near Heppner, stated a recent news release from Century West.
