**Morrow-Umatilla Humane Soc. new facility operating**



At the first regular meeting of 1982, Stokes Landing Humane Society President, Rose Hoosier, announced that the society was now financially sound and is operating in its new facility. The office, and 24-hour answering service, which serves west Umatilla and south Morrow counties, is located at Lin's Idle Palace at 1035 N. First Street in Hermiston in space donated by its owner, Lin Severns.

President Hoosier noted that in October there had been some doubt that the society could continue due to lack of funds—that the Old & New Thrift Shop, which had provided partial support, had been closed in November and a public appeal was made for support.

In other business the society board of directors:

— Considered the need for control of stray dogs roaming the rural areas of both Morrow and Umatilla counties and took action to appoint a fact-finding committee to report back to the March meeting.

— Announced the receipt of a donation of a special fund for animal assistance, primarily in the area of spaying and neutering of animals.

— Selected the method of euthanasia by injection of animals at the hands of local veterinarians as the method recommended for society use in the rare cases where it is needed, and strongly opposed
