## \$20 million expansion planned at U&I

U and I Corporation of Boardman is currently planning a \$20 million expansion which will include converting their machinery to gas powered operation, the Gazette-Times learned recently.

According to Deane Seeger, Morrow County Planner Pacific Cascade Gas has proposed a 20 year franchise agreement with the county and the cities of Irrigon and Boardman. The agreement will allow Pacific Cascade's natural gas line to come across the Columbia River just west of the town of Umatilla. The line would continue through Irrigon and end in Boardman at the Port of Morrow.

Seeger explained that a counter proposal is currently being drawn up by Morrow County and the cities of Boardman and Irrigon, requesting that two percent of the gross sales be returned to each district.

The proposed gas line will be sufficient for residents of Boardman and Irrigon to also tap into, stated Seeger.

"I'm very pleased about this opportunity for the county and the residents of Irrigon and Boardman," he said. "This will offer another source of energy for people and maybe be some competition for these high electrical rates."

The proposed gas conversion project would cost approximately \$3 million and Cascade Gas expects the line to be completed in August of this year, said Seeger.
