### FOOD FACTS & FANCIES



It may seem like just a fancy, but it's quite true—entirely new kinds of food plants are sprouting in the test tubes of agricultural laboratories around the globe. The U.S. Department of Agriculture has just announced a number of important breakthroughs, including the successful transfer of a high-protein gene from a bean seed into a sunflower cell, known now as the "sunbean," and the successful union of the potato and tomato, aptly called the "pomatoe."



Agricultural scientists are using genetic engineering techniques to develop plants that have the same high-quality protein as animal foods, and are also pest resistant, can fertilize themselves and enrich the soil, and can grow and produce well in drought conditions. In fact, the nutritional equivalent of beef may one day be reproduced in plants, such as genetically engineered corn—which may someday be known as "beef-corn."

The experts at Bethesda Research Laboratories (BRL) think that genetic engineering techniques will be a big part of the 1980s, expanding into the dairy, baking and brewing industries.
