Tractor driving contest in 3rd year at fair

This will be the third year for the 4-H and FFA Tractor Driving Contest. It is an interesting and exciting event for spectators. This year the contest will be held August 24 at 1 p.m. in the rodeo arena. The contest is open to both 4-H and

FFA members.

Contestants will first pass a written safety and operation test before attempting the driving part of the contest. The course is designed to test the safe and skillful operation of standard farm equipment. Typical obstacles are: using a tractor with three point pallet forks, using a tractor with a front-end loader, backing a trailer through a course, and balancing a tractor on a

"teeter-totter."

Course designer, Roger Records (co-chairman and Heppner Vo Ag instructor as well as FFA advisor), has had several years of experience setting up the tractor driving contest at Oregon State Fair.

Contestants must present a signed parental release statement before taking the written test. Forms are available from Roger Records or John Nordheim.
