Ione Garden Club learns of flower arranging

New Designs and Mechanics of Flower Arranging was demonstrated by Mrs. Pete Slocum of Hermiston for members of the Ione Garden Club and guests on Wednesday, September 8, at the Ione United Church of Christ. Mrs. Slocum is a member of the Bloomer Girls Garden Club, the District No. 10 Flower Arrangers Guild and has finished Phase III of Flower Judging School.

Mrs. Slocum stated that flower arranging is now a recognized art form both for self enjoyment and competition. To be a successful arranger, she said, one must know about the basic principles of design and of the mechanics, such as containers, needle holders, frogs and other holders and oasis. Also, one must understand how to condition flowers and greenery. These should be picked after the sun goes down or before it rises and be plunged immediately into tepid water, she pointed

out.

There are many types of arrangements, including traditional, conventional, creative, abstract and free form designs. The new designs are often not technically arrangements, but are known as abstracts or free form designs. To demonstrate this, Mrs. Slocum made arrangements with a horizontal line, a crescent, a vertical line and a free form.

She also told the group she uses Marie Miller's book "New Dimensions in Floral Design." Sutter's book "New Approach in Design Principles." Asher's book "The Complete Flower Arranger" and Better Homes and Gardens "Flower Arranging."

An exhibit of horticulture specimens and arrangements prepared by members were displayed around the room. Following the demonstration refreshments were served by the committee of Delta Huber, Dorothy Burchan, Loree Hubbard and Helen Martin.
