The Morrow County Public Works Department has released the following Work Report for the week ending October 23:

Roads bladed and graveled this past week were: Hale Ridge, Stock Drive, B. McLaughlin and Lonerock Road. Bladed only were Fuller Canyon and E.W. Stock Drive Road.

On Willow Creek Road, soft spots were dug up and replaced with base rock and gravel. Then cold mix was bladed over these areas.
