fuel assistance worker and when checks are processed by the state fuel assistance computer is about two weeks.

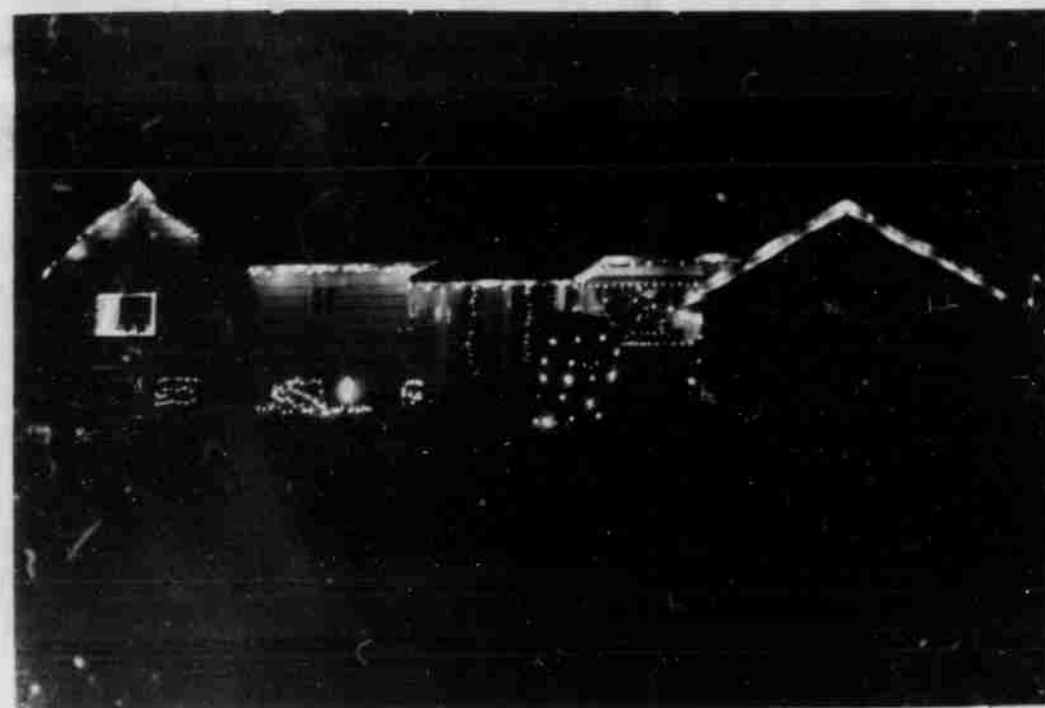
A W.I.C. clinic will be held Tuesday, Dec. 28, for those that are eligible for that program.
