NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to ORS 311.615 of the service of Personal Property Tax warrants upon the following listed tax payers. Payment of the following listed delinquent taxes with interest and costs of service must be made by March 10, 1983 or said warrants shall be filed with the County Clerk of Morrow County, Oregon, to be entered in the judgment docket of said county and shall become a lien upon the title to any interest in real property owned by the person against whom the warrant is issued, and the taxes thereon, shall continue as a lien on all the personal property of the person assessed as otherwise provided by law.
