DECISION NOTICE AND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT FISCAL YEAR 1983 VEGETATION MANAGEMENT PROJECT WHEELER COUNTY, OREGON
 USDA Forest Service
 Umatilla National Forest

An Environmental Assessment that addresses the proposed Fiscal Year 1983 Vegetation Management Project is available for public review at the District Ranger's Office in Heppner, Oregon.

Based on the analysis and evaluation described in the Environmental Assessment it is my decision to adopt the alternative selected in Table 1 as the method of treatment and management for these National Forest system lands. The alternative provides for the hand chemical treatment of planting spots on 45 acres of forest land to reduce grass competition with newly planted tree seedlings. Other alternatives considered included no treatment, hand scalping and mechanical scarification.

This alternative with the specified management requirements, constraints, and mitigation measures, is considered to be the environmentally preferred alternative.

Based on the Environmental Assessment, I have determined that this is not a major federal action that would significantly affect the quality of the human environment, and is within the scope of the Heppner Planning Unit FEIS; therefore, I find an environmental impact statement is not needed.

Implementation of this project may take place immediately upon the signing and dating of this Decision Notice.

This decision is subject to administrative review (appeal) pursuant to 36 CFR 211.18. A written notice of appeal must be filed with the District Ranger within 45 days from the date of this Decision Notice.
