### CowBelles to do demonstrations

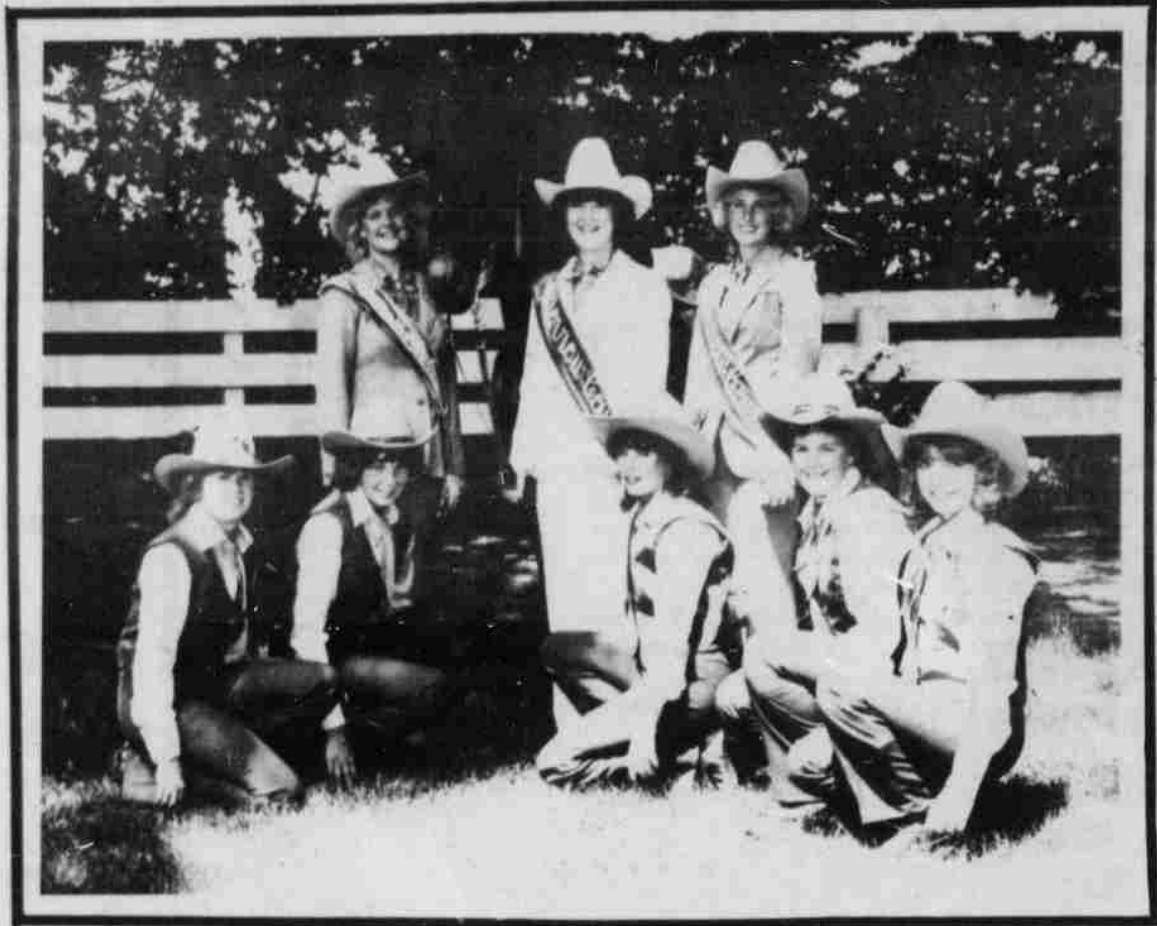

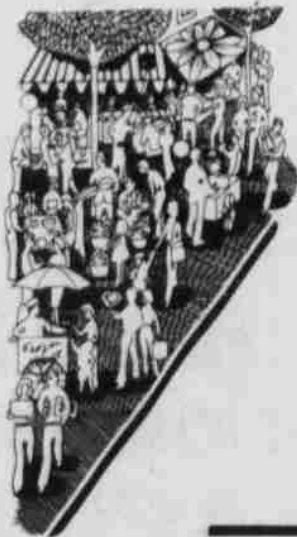
