

# Mustangs lose season opener to Riverside 6-7

Eric Thompson led the action in Heppner's Friday night game against the Riverside Pirates by making a touchdown on a 16-yard reverse in the first quarter.

The Mustangs then attempted to kick for the extra point but failed, leaving the Pirates an opening to get ahead, which happened when Tyler Trumbull made a touchdown in the second quarter as he bootlegged on the outside with only 12 yards to go. Their attempt for the extra point was successful.

Despite the effort of the Mustangs, the Pirates won by a one-point margin, 7-6. "I feel we outplayed them. We definitely out rushed and out passed them. The execution for the first game was acceptable, but we can do better," commented Heppner Coach Craig Kitching. "We found out that we can play every bit as good as Riverside. We came together as a team and saw what it takes to win a ball game."

Defensively the players had some breakdowns in their assignments, but as the coach said, "Their effort was good. You can't fault their effort. They had mental lapses that

won't happen later in the year."

For the team's first game, their offensive playing was quite successful. "We had one penalty in the whole ball game. We didn't go outside or in motion. We gave our backs room to run and they ran hard. We moved the ball fairly well. Right now we need to work on finishing their drives."

The starting lineup consisted of John Moyer, Cam George, Archie Lucas alternating with Eric Thompson, Rod Cole, John Martin, Bob Harris, Bob McEwen, Mark Way, Tom Hamman, Jim McConnell and Stan Sporseen.

Sporseen was injured later in the game as he made a tackle which caused a pile up out of bounds. The ball carrier fell on top of him, pushing the back of his helmet into his neck, causing his neck to be hyper extended. He was carefully lifted onto the stretcher and loaded into the ambulance to be taken to the hospital as a precautionary measure. Rick Riehl was then put into the game to take Sporseen's place.

When asked who were the mainstays on the team, Coach Kitching replied, "I can't say,

we're a team. It was a complete team effort. A few stood out in my mind, but the backs are only as good as their line. The only way to look good as a team is if everyone does their job."

Heppner has a lot to be proud of in their team, and so does Kitching. "I am proud of the way we held them scoreless in the second half."

Riverside spectators were surprised and impressed by Heppner's stamina and energy compared to their size, and even though the Mustangs were disappointed at their loss, they walked off of the field showing much pride.

"I didn't feel like I was in a losing locker room," replied Kitching. "We knew we outplayed them and were the winning team. We knew we had done a good job and had nothing to be ashamed of. I was impressed. We took positive things out of the loss."

Kitching wanted to express his thanks for the spectators that came to watch and cheer on the Mustangs. He said that it helps the team knowing that people are supporting them, but that his attention is always on the game, and adding, "I wish we could have

won for them" (the spectators).

The Mustangs will face Weston-McEwen Thursday night on the Mustangs' home field in Heppner at 7:30 p.m.

"They're tough as nails (Weston-McEwen). They go out and attack people. We're going to have our hands full. Whoever wants the most is going to get it," assured Kitching. "We're going to have to use the same strategy as against Riverside, except that we must put the ball into the endzone."

He also felt that, "We're going to be stronger. Show up Thursday and we'll show them what we can do."

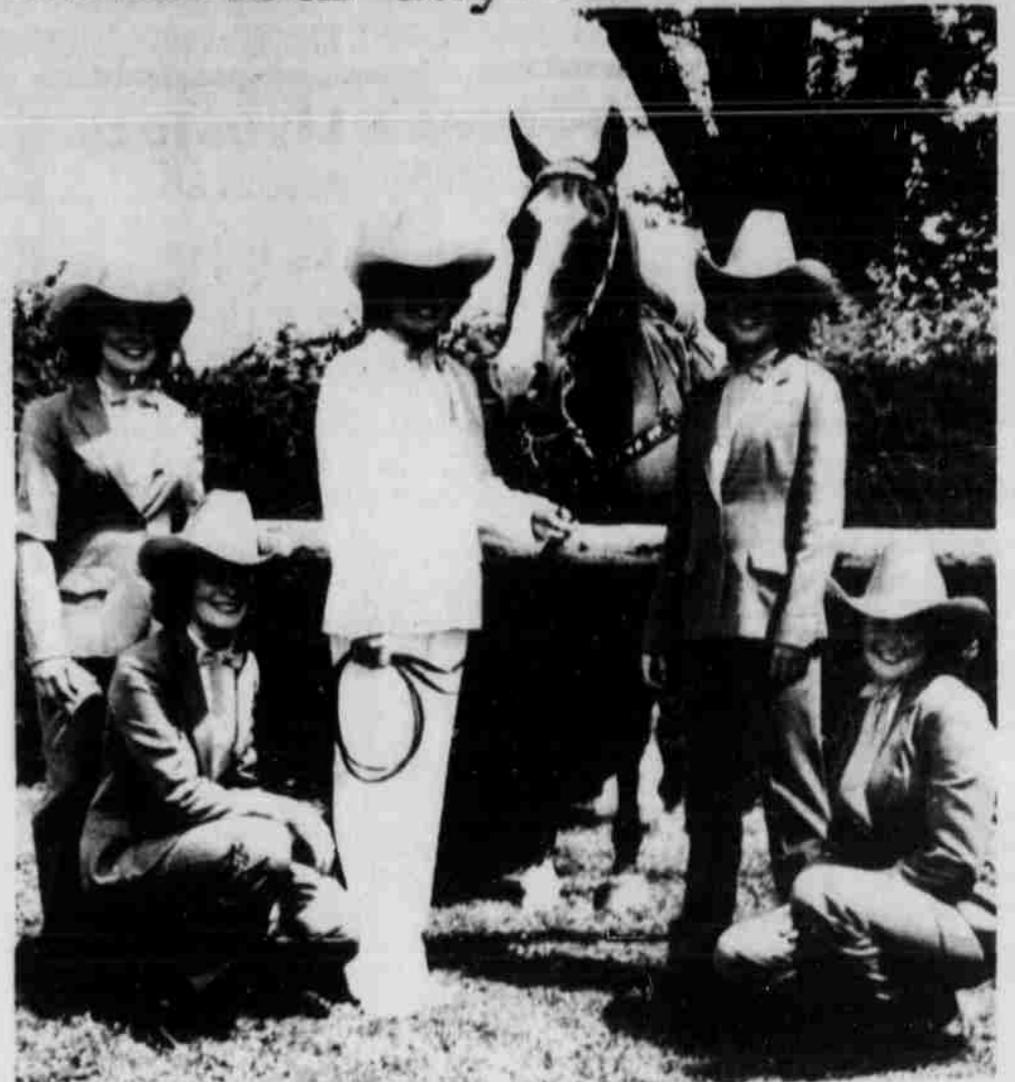
