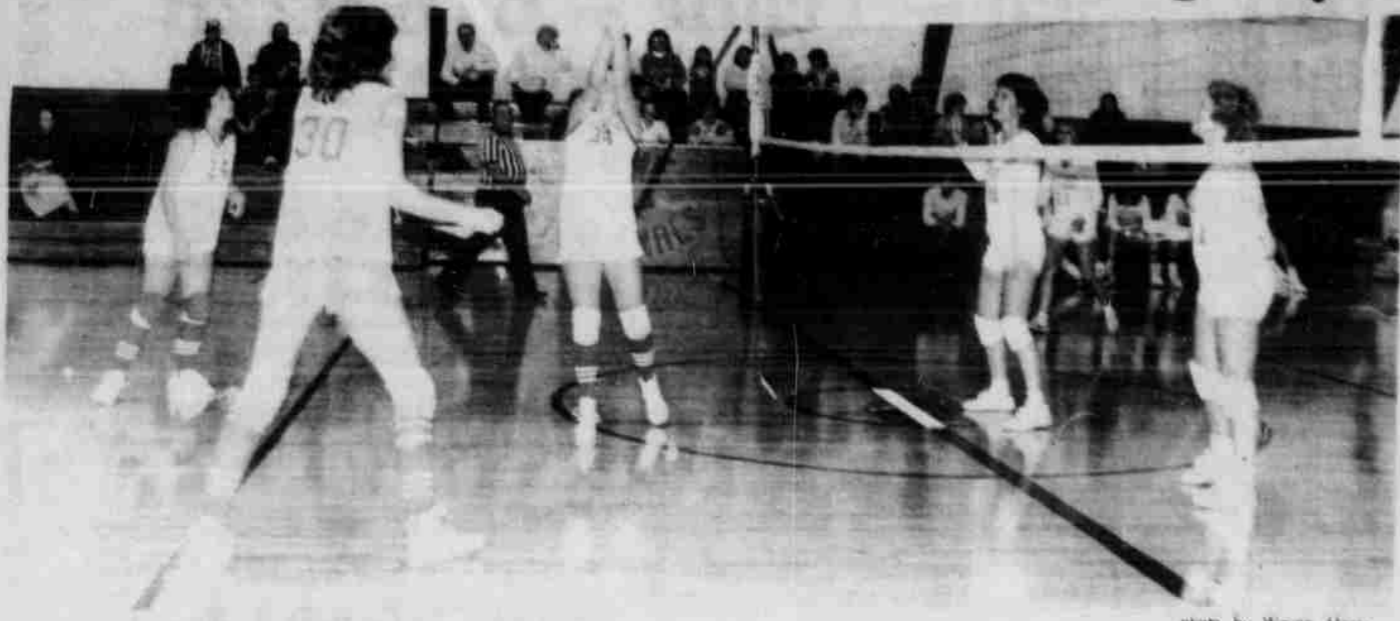


Loss to Echo leaves Ione 0-4 in Big Sky

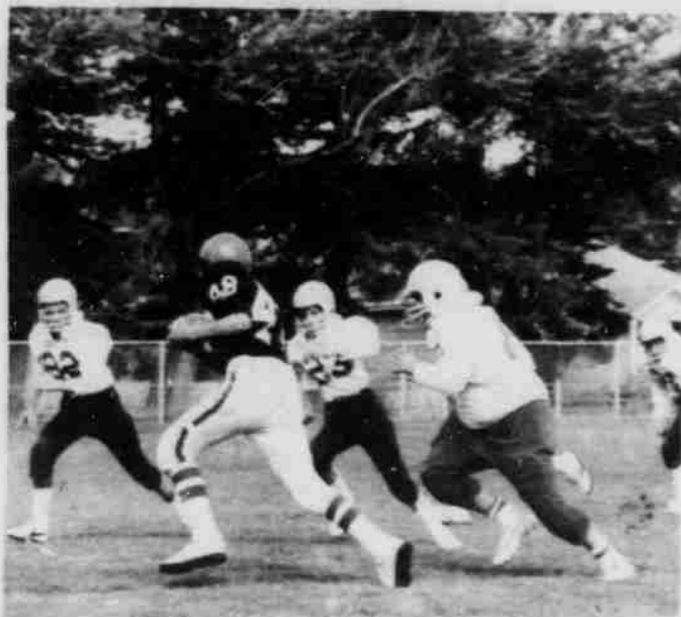


Kim McCabe (34) returns volley against Echo, while Sandi Wright (30) and Candi Rudisill (24) look on.
