

SOMEONE'S IN THE KITCHEN WITH MOMMA

Autumn days bring more than colorful leaves. They often bring cool, damp weather. Turning a rainy day into a fun day is easy when you let the little ones join you in a grey day "baking party." Learning to cook is lots of fun, especially when what's baking is chocolate.

Easy recipes are the perfect way to start teaching a junior baker. They involve a minimal amount of ingredients and preparation steps. And young cooks will be as delighted to serve these snacks as kids (of all ages) will be to enjoy them.

For a triple chocolate treat, bake up these Nutty Chocolate Squares. Chocolate cake, chocolate pudding and chocolate chips team up in a deliciously moist bar cookie.

NUTTY CHOCOLATE SQUARES
1 package chocolate almond, chocolate fudge chip, German chocolate coconut pecan or golden chocolate chip cake mix
1 cup milk
1 package (4 1/8 ounces) chocolate instant pudding and pie filling
1/2 cup chopped nuts
1/2 cup semisweet chocolate chips

Heat oven to 350°. Grease bottom only of rectangular pan, 13x9x2 inches. Prepare cake mix as directed on package except—mix in bowl and substitute milk for the water. Stir in pudding and pie filling (dry) with the milk. (Batter will be thick.) Spread in pan. Sprinkle with nuts. Bake 15 minutes; sprinkle chocolate chips over top. Bake until wooden pick inserted in center comes clean, about 10 minutes longer. Cool completely. Cut into about 1 1/2-inch squares. 48 squares.

Nutty Butterscotch Squares: Use applesauce raisin, banana walnut, butter pecan, carrot nut, coconut pecan, date nut or spice raisin cake mix. Substitute 1 package (3 1/2 ounces) vanilla instant pudding and pie filling for the chocolate pudding and pie filling and butterscotch chips for the chocolate chips.

High Altitude Directions (3500 to 6500 feet): Heat oven to 375°. Stir 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour into cake mix (dry).

Chocolate and banana flavors blend in this Chocolate Fudge Sundae Cake which bakes in its own pan for easy cleanup. It's crowned with a creamy whipped topping made from its own packet of frosting.

CHOCOLATE FUDGE SUNDAE CAKE
Prepare 1 package devil's food cake mix as directed except—decrease water to 1/2 cup; add 1/4 cup mashed ripe banana. Serve with Chocolate-Cherry Whipped Topping
