Both runners completed the 26.2 mile course. Beck in 2 hrs., 48 min., and Vinson in 3 hrs., 36 min.

Beck, 37, tries to run each day, averaging from eight to nine miles. Vinson, 34, also tries to run every day, averaging seven miles per day during the winter and 10 miles a day during warmer months.

The Portland Marathon was Vinson's first, although he has participated in many other runs. The Portland race was about Beck's 12th marathon.

Chris Shen led the Eagle scoring attack with 13 points. Besides Douglas and Rietmann, Steve Millman scored eight for Ione.

The Cards were 6 of 16 from the charity stripe, 38 percent. The Eagles were one for five, 20 percent.

Ione will play host to the Heppner freshmen on Friday, Dec. 9, and will travel to Boardman to play the Riverside J.V. team on Saturday, Dec. 10. Both games will start at 4:30 p.m.
