

Mustangs triumph over Cards

John Martin's inside domination led the Heppner Mustangs to a 56-43 triumph over the Ione Cardinals in a non-conference game last Friday night.

Martin made eight of 12 shots and finished with 17 points. Greg Orr and Mark Way contributed eight apiece and Rod Cole pulled down nine rebounds.

Heppner had a slight edge at the foul line out-scoring Ione there 12-9. Archie Lucas made five of seven free throws for the Mustangs. But Martin was the big difference. "I'm not

sure. I think John could play much better, but he played excellent, and gave us what we need at the post position," said Heppner Coach Brent Eggers.

Mark Meyers topped Ione with 11 points and was followed by Randy McCabe with nine. The Mustangs started out quick with a 17-8 lead at the end of the first quarter and never looked back. Heppner led by 10 after the third quarter, but Ione's minor comeback wasn't good enough to defeat the Mustangs.

"We played an excellent three quarters," said Eggers.

The Mustangs upped their win-loss record to 2-1.

Ione varsity team loses to HHS Mustangs 43-56

The Ione Cardinal boys' varsity basketball team lost for the first time this season to the Heppner Mustangs 56 to 43 on Friday, Dec. 9.

Ione had a slow start in the opening stanza and Heppner took advantage taking a 17-8 lead.

Heppner out-scored the Cardinals 11 to 8 in the second quarter to lead at intermission 28 to 16.

The Mustangs continued their lead in the third period taking a 47 to 27 lead as John Martin and Mark Way each scored eight points.

All of the Mustang points in the fourth quarter were scored from the free throw line. Doherty scored all six of his points in the quarter for Ione.

Heppner out-rebounded Ione 34 to 24. Rod Cole and Martin had nine and eight rebounds respectively for the Mustangs. Doherty and Craig Hams each had five for the Cards. Hams also had seven assists.

Mark Meyers and Randy McCabe scored 11 and nine points respectively for Ione.

Martin led Heppner with 17. Way and Greg Orr added eight and Cole contributed seven.

Turnovers were a major factor in the Cardinal loss. Ione committed 32 to 24 for the Mustangs.

From the free throw line, Ione made 9 of 18 shots for 50 percent, while Heppner hit 12 of 29 shots for 41 percent. Heppner made 22 of 53 field goals

for compared to 17 of 49 for 35 percent for Ione.

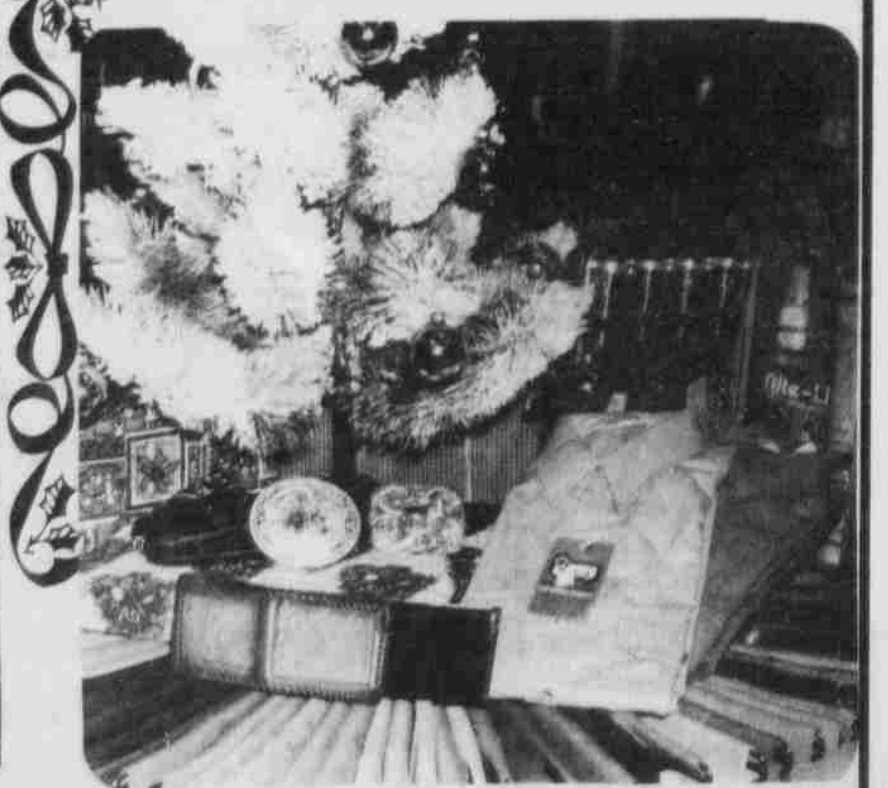
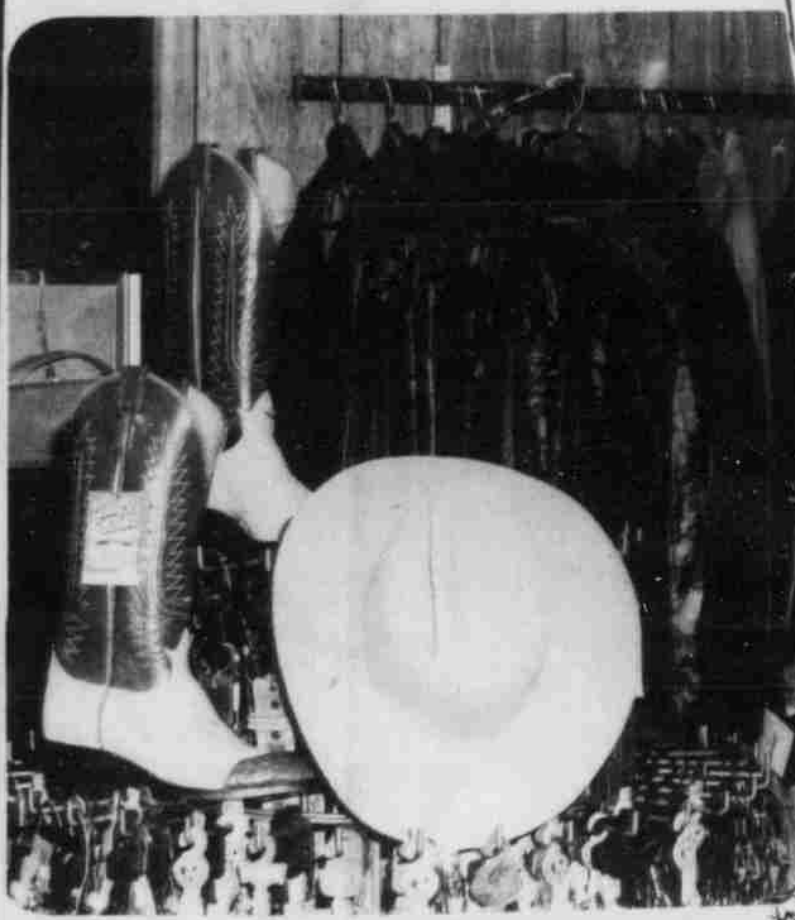
