The Ione High Schools girls' basketball team fell to 2-3 with a 45-28 loss to the Riverside Pirettes on Tuesday, Dec. 13.

Riverside took a 12 to 7 lead in the first quarter. Dawn Timms, Mesha Gaines and Kim Musgrove all scored four each for the Pirettes.

Ione was held to just three points in the second stanza as Riverside increased their lead to 24-10 at halftime.

Deena Hams had the hot hand in the third period as she scored all eight of the Cardinal points as Ione trailed by 17, 35-18.

Both teams scored 10 points in the fourth quarter, but it wasn't enough for Ione as Riverside won 45 to 28. Sandi Wright tossed in seven in the quarter for Ione.

From the free throw line the Pirettes made one of five shots for 20 percent. The Cardinals connected on six of 18 shots for 33 percent. Ione made 11 of 36 field goals, 31 percent. Riverside made 22 of 54 shots, 41 percent.

Hams and Wright scored 12 and 11 points respectively. Gaines took game high scoring honors with 13.

The Cards pulled down 22 rebounds. Wright got eight and Hams got six.

The Falcons took a 14-8 lead after the first period. Deena Hams and Sandi Wright each scored four points for Ione in the period.

Wheeler exploded for 21 second stanza points to take a 35-17 halftime lead. Julie Vanswoll and Barb Caldera both scored six in the stanza for the Falcons.
