

# Stock dog demonstrations added to Mar. 17 activities



Cliff Steelman of Walla Walla, Wash. will be conducting stock dog demonstrations on Saturday, Mar. 17, in conjunction with Heppner's St. Patrick's Day celebration. Two demonstrations are scheduled at the Morrow County Fairgrounds near the grandstands. The first will begin at 3 p.m., followed by another at 4 p.m.

Stelman, who breeds and trains primarily Boarder Collies, has six dogs of his own. Bob, the dog he will use for the demonstrations with sheep, is blind.

On Sunday, Mar. 18, Steelman will conduct a stock dog clinic beginning at 8 a.m. at the fairgrounds. Topics to be covered at the clinic will include the health and care of new pups, outruns, gather and fetch, driving, penning and shedding. The clinic should conclude between 4 and 5 p.m.

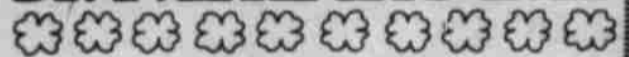
Last year viewers were treated to musical selections from six members of the Mike Kenny family. This year the Robert Wilson family will be featured guests.

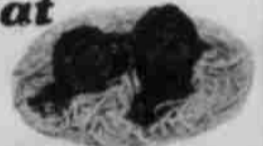
