

Photo scheduled for descendants of Hibernia Society on St. Patrick's Day

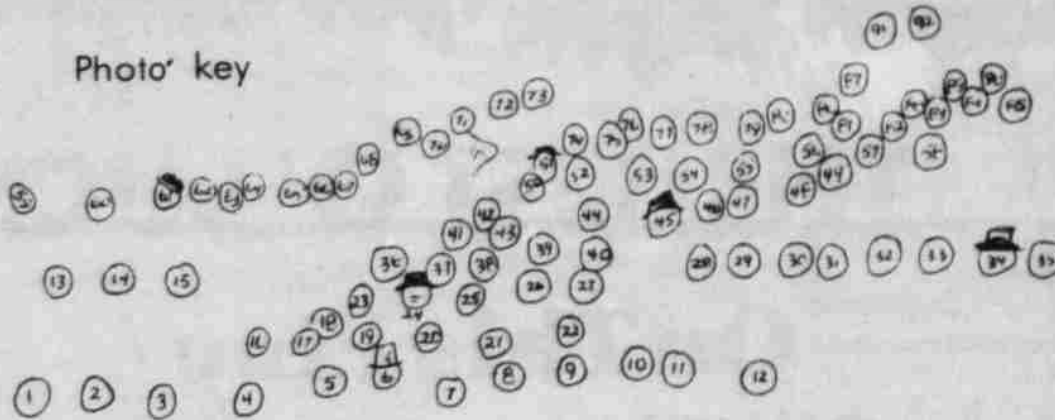
