Joyce Hughes will be coordinating an Aerob-a-thon in Heppner on Monday, April 23 at 6:00 p.m. It will be held in the Heppner Grade School multi-purpose room.

Interested participants can pick up their sponsor forms by calling Joyce Hughes at 989-8412. Participants will then need to sign up sponsors who are willing to pledge so much (i.e. 10 cents) for each minute of continuous exercise.

Cystic Fibrosis is an inherited disease that attacks the lungs and digestive system. It is estimated that one of every 20 Americans is a symptomless carrier of the gene which can cause CF in their child. Through research funded by the Foundation, a test to identify carriers is being sought and scientists are pursuing a cure or control for CF. Public contributions for research and patient care have extended the life expectancy from age six 15 years ago to age 21 today.
