## DIVISION 3 — 4-H MASTER SHOWMANSHIP - LARGE ANIMALS

PREMIUMS

Blue - \$6.00, Red - \$5.00, White - \$4.00

RULES:

- Champion showman of each species to compete.
- In the event that Grand Champion does not elect to compete for Master Showman, Reserve Champion may then compete.
- The decision not to compete is final.

SCORING:

1. Fitting of own animal ..... 50 points
2. Showmanship of other animals ..... 50 points each
3. Showmanship of own animal - after showing all others ..... 50 points

## DIVISION 4 — 4-H MASTER SHOWMANSHIP - SMALL ANIMALS

PREMIUMS

Blue - \$6.00, Red - \$5.00, White - \$4.00

RULES:

- Champion showman of each species to compete.
- In the event that Grand Champion does not elect to compete for Master Showman, Reserve Champion will then compete.
- The decision not to compete is final.

SCORING:

1. Fitting of own animal ..... 50 points
2. Showmanship of other animals ..... 50 points each
3. Showmanship of own animal after showing all others ..... 50 points

## DEPT. IV POULTRY, RABBITS & SMALL ANIMALS

Small animals will be accepted 8 p.m. Sunday, August 12.

- All animals must be pre-registered by July 29, before 5 p.m. at County Extension Office.

All 4-H members must be present to show their exhibits. They will carry them to the judging table and show them while they are being judged.

- Care of entries. Cages and pens must be kept clean and neat by the member.
- Failure of exhibitor to tend his animal shall result in forfeiture of any or all premiums. Premium checks will not be released until pens are cleaned.
- Judge will specify animals judged as fat stock that are eligible for sale.
- Small animals will be accepted from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. Sunday, August 12.

## DIVISION 1 — 4-H POULTRY

RULES:

- 4-H birds will be disqualified for any of the following defects: crooked feet, leg, spine, blindness, absence of tail feathers, dirty or for having any other defects or ailments. This will relate to showmanship as well.

- Entries in single classes cannot compete in pens.
- Recognized breeds will be judged separately (Poultry Breed Classification Guide)

-For Small Animal Showmanship, Small Animal Herdsmanship, Small Animal Judging Contest, or Round Robin Showmanship look under Dept. III-4-H Animal Contests.

LOT

1. Pullet - hatched this year
2. Cockerel - hatched this year
3. Hen - over one year
4. Cock - over one year
5. Hen with chicks of same breed, at least two weeks
6. Pen
  - A. Cockerel and two pullets
  - B. Cock and two hens

CLASS E — Market Chickens (all breeds compete together)

LOT

1. Broiler, 2½ lbs. to 4 lbs. — no more than 8 weeks
2. Roaster, 4 lbs. to 6½ lbs. — no more than 16 weeks
3. Pen of three
  - A. Broilers, 7½ lbs. to 12 lbs. total weight — under 8 weeks
  - B. Roasters, 12 lbs. to 19½ lbs. total weight — under 16 weeks

CLASS F — Ducks

LOT

1. Young duck — hatch this year
2. Young drake — hatch this year
3. Old duck — over one year
4. Old drake — over one year
5. Duck with ducklings of same breed
6. Pen — drake with two ducks
7. Single market duck, weight
8. Pen of three market ducks
