### FFA HERDSMANSHIP CONTEST

— Livestock will be tied or penned in sections.  
 — Each exhibitor must keep his tack and stall or pen clean and presentable at all times. Hay and straw is not to be used in bales behind animals.  
 — Judge will inspect the stalls and pens of each exhibitor at regular intervals and keep a record to determine the winners.  
 — Exhibitors will be judged individually.
