### CBEC workmen rebuild line

Columbia Basin Electric Co-op workmen and equipment have been rebuilding the old Pacific Power and Light electric line along Cowins Street in Heppner. The line was strung in the late 1930s according to Fred Toombs, manager of C.B.E.C., and some of the poles were rotting and the wire was too small for present usage.

The line is being replaced with a larger, heavier wire and new taller poles which will be farther off the street. The new line will require fewer poles because a better quality wire allows longer spans of wire without support.

The new line, Toombs says is part of the continuous updating program by C.B.E.C. to provide better service to customers.

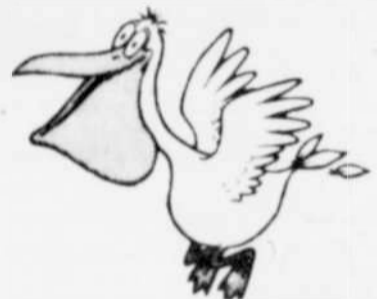
