The case was heard here before Judge Fred W. Wilson of The Dalles.

25 Years Ago

October 22, 1959

Heppner firemen extinguished a blaze in the Jack Everly home on the Condon Highway Wednesday morning before the fire had an opportunity to destroy the house, which only recently had been moved to the site from a downtown location. Mr. and Mrs. Everly were on their way to Portland when the fire broke out and had left the house only minutes before. Damage was estimated by Chief C.A. Ruggles at about \$600.

The Morrow County District Attorney's office in the Morrow County Courthouse in Heppner reports conducting the following business during the past week:

Randy Jackson Kimble of Boardman entered a plea of Not Guilty to Criminal Mischief in the Third Degree and Disorderly Conduct.

Jose Saul Jacquez, 30, of Hermiston was found Guilty of Driving While Revoked. He was sentenced to a one year jail sentence and one year bench probation.

Henry M. Carr, 27, of Hermiston was found guilty of three counts of Burglary in the First Degree and sentenced to 60 days in the Umatilla County Jail with five years probation.

WOOD STOVE SAFETY

- DO NOT... Use any flammable fuels to ignite wood including charcoal lighter.
- DO NOT... Extend smoke pipe through walls or ceilings unless proper installation procedures are followed. (Refer to illustrations)
- DO NOT... Do anything that will cause sudden change of temperature in stove.
- DO NOT... Connect a wood stove to a fireplace chimney unless the fireplace has been sealed off.
- DO NOT... Ever leave the fire to burn unattended or overnight. A wood-burning heater is not an automatic device and needs constant attention.
