The Heppner Mustangs fell to 0-7 on the season, with a 34-12 loss at Lyle Washington Friday night. Lyle, a non conference team was also wireless going into the night's action. The Mustangs came out strong and looked very impressive on their first drive, which lasted seven minutes capped by a two yard run by Scott Buschke.

But before the Mustangs could have time to celebrate their touchdown, the Trojans threw a 70 yard pass on the third play of their first drive.

"Our tendency to give up the big scoring play hurt us again this week," said Coach Craig Kitching.

The Trojans scored on a forty yard interception thrown by Ron Doherty in the second quarter to lead at halftime 14-6. Then the bottom fell out for the Mustangs in the third quarter, when two more touchdowns were thrown by the Trojan quarterback to raise their lead to 26-6. The Mustangs closed to within 14 points on a quarterback sneak by Joe Taylor who replaced the injured

Doherty. But Lyle capped it off on a 56 yard run by Aaron Lee, who ended up with 115 yards on 13 carries.

"We put together several good drives, two leading to touchdowns," said Kitching.

The Mustangs play at Stanfield Friday night at 7:30.
